## **FURTHER REGULATIONS**

#### SR 109 - POSTPONEMENT / CANCELLATION OF EVENT

SR 109 (1) is altered to read:

"In case of cancellation, postponement for more than 24 hours, or abandonment, Entry Fees shall be returned within 30 days of the date of cancellation unless the competitor states his/her intention of competing in a postponed competition to the Promoter within 30 days of the notice of postponement".

### Explanation

The above requires competitors to advise the Promoter of intention not to compete in the event to be held 1-7 November by 1700 hours on 30 June 2020; by not doing so it will be assumed the competitor intends to compete and from 1 July 2020 SR 204.5 (as adjusted for the November event) will apply (see below)

#### 204.5 Refunds

Refund of payments due to competitor withdrawal from the event will be as follows:

- no refund shall be made of the \$1,000 nomination fee:
- withdrawal between 1 January and 31 July 2020 25% of other monies paid retained;
- withdrawal between 1 August and 10 October 2020 50% of other monies paid retained;
- withdrawal after 10 October 2020 and prior to noon 7 November 2020 75% of other monies paid retained:
- no refunds will be made after noon 7 November 2020;

The initial \$1,000 nomination fee, together with any further payments made, may be transferred to another nomination or entry, provided it is a new entry and not one being held by the Organisers.
