**FURTHER REGULATIONS**

**SR 109 - POSTPONEMENT / CANCELLATION OF EVENT**

SR 109 (1) is altered to read:

"In case of cancellation, postponement for more than 24 hours, or abandonment, Entry Fees shall be returned within 30 days of the date of cancellation unless the competitor states his/her intention of competing in a postponed competition to the Promoter within 30 days of the notice of postponement".

Explanation

The above requires competitors to advise the Promoter of intention not to compete in the event to be held 1-7 November by 1700 hours on 30 June 2020; by not doing so it will be assumed the competitor intends to compete and from 1 July 2020 SR 204.5 (as adjusted for the November event) will apply (see below)

**204.5 Refunds**

Refund of payments due to competitor withdrawal from the event will be as follows:

- no refund shall be made of the \$1,000 nomination fee;
- withdrawal between 1 January and 31 July 2020 - 25% of other monies paid retained;
- withdrawal between 1 August and 10 October 2020 – 50% of other monies paid retained;
- withdrawal after 10 October 2020 and prior to noon 7 November 2020 - 75% of other monies paid retained;
- no refunds will be made after noon 7 November 2020;

The initial \$1,000 nomination fee, together with any further payments made, may be transferred to another nomination or entry, provided it is a new entry and not one being held by the Organisers.
