The frustration continues but I only hope that the light at the end of the tunnel is not our Premier Dan's torch!!

Although still 5 months away the end of March next year, is looking a little brighter regarding the COVID-19. I trust that all the officials, competitors and service crews will all have been fully vaccinated allowing us to overcome the safety protocols that may be introduced.

All council's documentation requirements for the 9 shires have been resubmitted, for the 5th time, and I really appreciate their cooperation and understanding. We were granted permission last June through the NSW Police from the NSW government to close the 12 shire roads and to conduct the event for August this year so we will be resubmitting the updated documentation in November for their further consideration.

It has been encouraging to see the growing interest in next year's event, probably due to the frustration of not being able to get back out on the dirt for so long. Remember that due to the road closure times on the 12 magnificent shire roads we will be limited to a maximum field of 60 entries. We have 50 nominations to date and a further 15 who have sent notices of interest so the time has come to place your nomination in order to guarantee an entry.

Great to receive our first international entry from longtime supporter Warren Briggs out of the UK. He is shipping his magnificent Mustang over and no doubt staying with his brother/service crew, Blair in country NSW. All our other internationals who have entered in past events are waiting to see what restrictions will be in place next year. We live

It was, however, disappointing to see a clash of dates with the first round of the ARC in Canberra. I had looked at the possibility of moving our dates, but it would have meant moving to around May/June and with the problems of wet weather and back to the cold and possibly snow it was not going to happen. The COT represents just about a season of ARC events in 7 days and probably the last opportunity to take part in a long distance event.

What's next? We are waiting on Forests NSW to advise what, if any, changes we may need to make to our forest stages due to future planting, harvesting or road maintenance. Should we need to change or find new stages David and I will head off December/January and rewrite the road books ready for the final course check in early February. Then printing packing and off to Parkes 22nd March.
