FURTHER REGULATIONS

1. SR Article 105.1: Organising Committee (all Competitions)

Competitor Relations Officer (CRO)

Alan Baker (CAMS Official Licence Number 1073653 replaces Alan Patterson.

2. SR Article 301.3: Vehicle Classes (not Regularity)

The vehicle groups will be divided into classes based on actual engine capacity (as stated in the Entry Form), which will be as follows:

Class A: up to 1600cc Class B: 1601cc to 2000cc Class C: 2001cc to 3000cc Class D: over 3000cc.

As advised at 301.3 (1) each class will stand if three or more entries pass scrutiny in the class, otherwise a class will be amalgamated with the next higher or lower capacity class, or at the discretion of the organisers.

3. SR Article 301.4: Fuel (not Regularity)

A Summary of Distances/Refuel Information is listed at F2 and F3 in the GTE and will apply to the event.

4. SR Article 501: Documentation (all Competitions)

Covid-19 protocols are outlined at B6 Covid-19 in the GTE and will apply to the event.

5. Article 501.2: Reporting to Documentation & Article (all Competitions)

Report times to Documentation will be issued in a bulletin.

6. SR Article 601.5: Vehicle Odometer Course Distance Check (all Competitions)

Details are advised C1: Odometer Check Course in the GTE and will apply to the event

7. SR Article 608.1: Start of Event (all Competitions)

The details of the start of the event are outlined in the GTE at D4: Start of Events (Sunday 27th) and will apply to the event.

8. SR Article 903: Presentation of Awards (all Competitions

The Panthers Club hosting the presentation function will require all attendees to produce photo-identification regarding Covid-19 vaccination.
